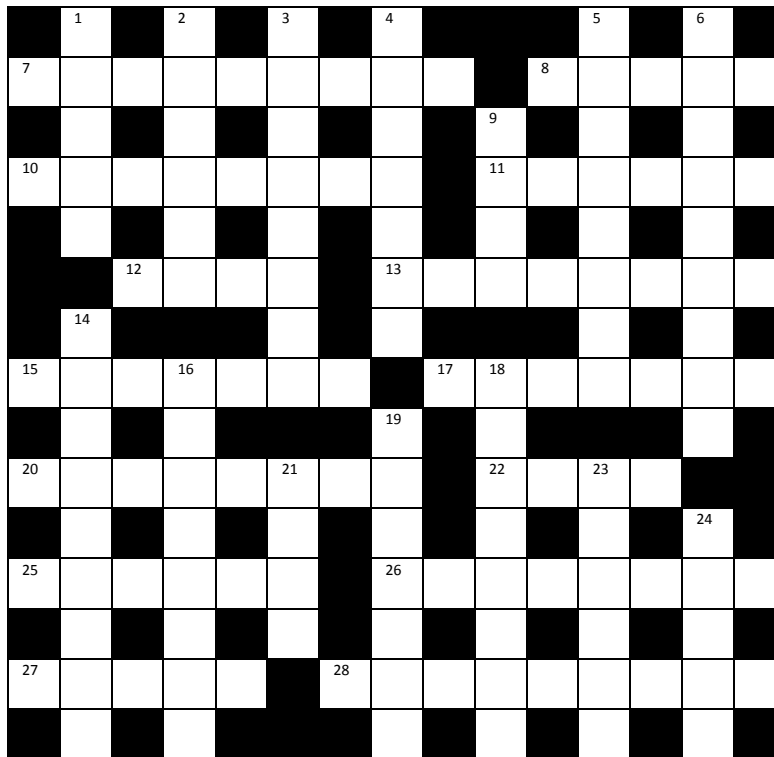

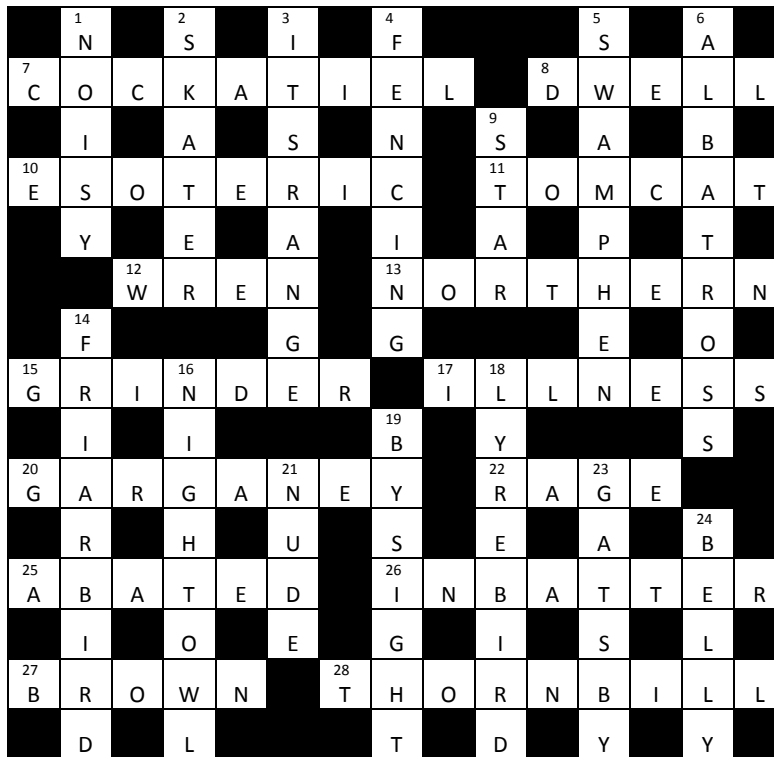
- 7 An inland parrot which is popularly kept in captivity (9)

 15 Scissors = Restless Flycatcher (7)
 17 Malady (7)
 20 *Anas* species which is a vagrant to Australia (8)

 27A, 28A Small *Acanthiza* species found in Eastern Australia (5, 9)
